hands upon. This is not our only queoane. Aquidote
the highest village of Capt Wynne is the promontory
which commands a view of scopus the straits &
the gulph of Volo - A private vessel anchored in Mousey
is land - The village is exposed to every attack
& the inhabitants are frightened out of their wits,
as they remember the tender mercies of the banditti
in the revolutionary war. From our windows
we see a Turkish brig, ^{& cutter} tacking backward &
forward watching the point of Neos. I see a large
Turkish steamer anchored just off the port of
Sakari - They ^{are} placed there to watch the coast but
to no purpose, as Greek boats go to the opposite
side with cargoes of ^{turkish} soldiers. The brig caught
however Gizzanos with sixty golicari, but the
boat having its papers inform, nothing could be
done & they were allowed to proceed on their way;
our armed Turkish force are stationed at hikere
& they might with the greatest ease, make a foray
into the island take Lenochori & Chalce every
village in its vicinity; Adrastacos is on
his way to monos for Scio - Protho came
last night with ammunition guns & biscuit for
Stibida: if the Greek government so generally up-
holds so openly the insurgents, we shall

soon have a band of Turks making reprisals,
upon our shores. - What are to become of
the English villages & families, are they
to resist the English Empire or not? &

This state of things is not to be trifled with, as
I have written before to Mr. Neill the Consul,
two, three times: To make this worse no
post has reached us for a month, have we
a government or have we not? So I suppose
is the port master, ^{of Chalco} that he will not send
