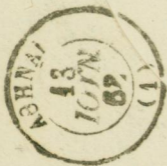

I am sure I must
apologize for not answering your
very kind letter of last month,
but the fact is I have delayed
writing as I wished to see
Lieut. Wilkinson, before doing so;-
if not troubling you too much

at any time you may have a spare
moment, will you kindly inform
me whether the Stadion is 1000 Metres
or is it generally calculated at 1083 $\frac{1}{3}$
English yards? — of course 1000 metres
would give 1093.6 yards. —

And also in the case of the
'Stremma', if 1000 sq. metres, it
would equal 0.24712 Acre (Eng), so
that 3 $\frac{1}{3}$ Stremmata would give
0.82391 Acre, instead of 1 Acre as
generally calculated. —
