Athens 18th March 1834.

Dear Sir,

I write this simply to acknowledge the receipt of yours of Nov. 29th 1833, enclosing a Bill, No. 158, on ~~Banking~~ Baring Brothers & Co. London, for £100.

The Box from Wilmington, Del. which you mention, I have just received.

The thing is now here on a visit - & to select a spot for a temporary palace - Last Sunday evening, the Athenians gave a Ball for him at Mr. Hill's School, which the authorities took for the purpose, quite contrary, I believe, to Mr. Hill's wishes - I do not know, as yet, precisely, on what principles they will pretend to justify themselves for such an act. Perhaps on the same, as when they took my school last year, for Mr. H.

We are all pretty well, & Mr. Pigg's is thinking of setting out, in about 8 or 10 days, on a journey into the Peloponnese - With best regards to Mr. Hill,
