

## British &amp; Foreign Bible Society

At a Meeting of the Sub Committee for general purposes held August 29. 1845.

Samuel Mills Esq. in the Chair

Resolved, after mature deliberation that in the opinion of this Sub Committee the Agency of the Rev. Mr. Hill at Athens cannot be continued with advantage to the Society.

Resolved That it be recommended to the General Committee to inform Mr. Hill that they feel obliged - though with great regret, remembering the very high testimonials under which his appointment had been made, - to close their connexion with him at the expiration of six months from the time of his entering on his appointment, namely on the 31<sup>st</sup> January 1846.

Resolved, That it be recommended to the Committee to request Professor Pambos & Mr. Nicolaides to resume their labours of revision - and to make a fair transcript of the work as its several parts are finished with a view to sending it to this Country, - and that for this purpose Mr. Hill do allow them access to the Chest in which the papers have been deposited they giving a receipt in writing for all such papers as they may have occasion to remove - and further that for their services the same rate of remuneration be continued to them as was adopted during the life of the Rev. H. D. Leves.
