My dear Mr Hill

Since I wrote
to you I have received
letters from Corfu & Trieste
by which I find that
all the troops in the Garrison
of Corfu are being changed
so that by the middle of
April all the Military
Candidates for Confirmation
will have left. The Chaplain
therefore wishes me to put
off my visit till the Autumn
and the Chaplain at Trieste

has resigned his Chaplaincy
and will not be there
to meet me. Under these
circumstances I think it
right to defer my visit
to Athens and the Ionian
islands till the Autumn.

In fact as the Chaplaincy
at Zante is vacant I
should have nothing to
do in the Island. I hope
this change of purpose may
not be inconvenient to you
and I trust that we shall
meet in the Autumn.

Mr Murray writes me word
that the Christian Knowledge
Society have granted [£]10
towards the restoration of
the Church at Uthens. So
that I hope you will manage
to get your wall erected.

If you have an Opportu-
nity will you send my
warmest congratulations to our
friend Misall on his Elevation
to the Episcopate. May he
be enabled to do much good
to his Diocese & his Church.
